Provision of 'Almshouse' accommodation for those of retirement age and limited financial means on behalf of the Manwood Charitable Trust. The works involve the refurbishment of the Grade $\rm II^*$ listed Manwood Hospital (2 existing Almshouses) and construction of 4 new.

The new builds sympathetically mirror the existing buildings to comply with strict planning regulations and preserve the heritage of the site. The design includes features such as English bonded-brickwork to create feature gable ends.

Preservation of the listed wall that surrounds the site was a key consideration amidst construction works.


